ACADIENCE READING SCORES

Our Trustland goal last year was that we would have a 5% increase in the number of students reaching proficiency on the end-of-year Acadience test. We attribute the jump from 2021 to 2023 to our targeted and systematic phonics instruction & intervention. We are continuously working on improving our literacy instruction to help our readers become even more proficient!
